Established in 2014 as a micro-boutique, craft winery in Beaverton, Oregon we are the first and only urban winery in the city. Our new location in Hillsboro places us as the only urban full-production winery in Hillsboro.

You'll find our passion is hand crafting high quality, small lot wines you can enjoy and celebrate. We source fruit from where it grows best. Our big bold reds feature grapes from the Yakima Valley AVA & Horse Heaven Hills AVA in Columbia Valley and whites and Pinot Noir highlight fruit from Willamette Valley.

### **Sparkling Wine**

**2021 Méthode Champenoise Blanc de Blancs Sparkling Wine (\$36)** This traditional method sparkling is as delightful as the 2019 vintage. On the nose Asian pear and clover honey. A hint of honey on the front palate, short bread midpalate with a pleasant pear finish. *Clements Hills nested in Lodi AVA, CA | 100% Chardonnay* 

## **Oregon White Wines (Willamette Valley)**

**2022 Viognier (\$26)** This cool-weather fruit has a fan following and we're thrilled to have it back on the shelf. Aromas of crisp green apple and papaya lead to that wake-up citrus of ruby-red grapefruit and a light lemon curd finish. *55 cases produced. 12.6% ABV Chateau LeBeau, Laurelwood District AVA, Chehalem Mountains.*  2021 Méthode Champenoise Rosé Sparkling Wine (\$36) Aroma hints of honeydew, fresh pear and bread dough. Crisp on the palate raspberry, bright red currant, light honeysuckle with essence of gumdrop spice transitions to orange blossom leaving a hint of mandarin orange at the finish. *Clements Hills nested in Lodi AVA, CA* 

**2022 Chardonnay (\$26)** Swirl to pick up the nose of light oak, melon, apple, pear, and clover honey. Full body in the mouth, chewy, light butter, hint of green apple, with a long-lasting finish. You'll find this a slightly higher acidity than a traditional Chardonnay. *88 cases produced. 12.4% ABV Scotch Church Road Vineyard, Tualatin Hills AVA* 

**2022** Rose of Pinot Noir (\$26) Beautifully soft pink in the glass, nose and palate greeted with apricot, plum, and caramel. Soft tannins and a balanced mouthfeel with nice minerality lead to a lingering finish. *78 cases produced*. *13.4% ABV*, *Tressler, Laurelwood District AVA, Chehalem Mountains*.

## Oregon Pinot Noir (Willamette Valley)

*Tressler Vineyard, Laurelwood District AVA, Chehalem Mountains Equal Parts Pinot Noir clones: Pommard, 113,115, 667,777* 

### 2020 Pinot Noir (\$36)

Fresh from the bottle the nose reveals the new oak barrel and a hint of the smoke from wildfires that were so prevalent in the Willamette Valley. Swirled in the glass oxygen lightens the nose and Pinot Noir fruit is evident. Full fruit in the mouth with hints of ripe plum. Round and full and the finish lingers with noticeable tannin. This wine will age gracefully for several years. *32 cases produced. 13.7% ABV* 8:59 PM

### 2020 Sangiovese, Super-Tuscan Style (\$40)

Bursting with fruit on first whiff. Carried up by higher alcohol to follow with raspberry, tart pie cherry and bold mouthfeel. Somewhat strong tannin lends to a long lingering finish. 6.9% Merlot 56 cases produced. 14.8% ABV

### 2020 Barbera (\$40)

Vanilla, toasted coconut and baking spice initially. Followed by ripe blackberry or Marionberry and dried cherries. Fruit carries on, balanced and smooth on the palate. Pleasant finish, minimal acidic bite for a Barbera. Medium long finish with pleasantly soft tannin. *53 cases produced. 14.5% ABV* 

### 2020 Vino Barbitivo (\$48)

*53% Barbera / 47% Primitivo* Nice deep red color. Ripe cherries, raspberry, big rich fruit up front. Smooth and balanced mouthfeel. Soft tannin in a finish that lingers nicely. Just a luscious wine. *28 cases produced 14.1% ABV*

### 2020 Malbec (\$40)

Rich ruby color. Cedar, sandalwood incense, coffee in the initial aroma. Chocolate, cocoa powder, eucalyptus as the wine gets some oxygen. Dark cherry aroma and taste. Balanced mouthfeel, decent acidity. Soft tannin and long finish. *30 cases produced.* 14% ABV

### 2019 Cabernet Franc (\$40) 👅 2023 PDX Wine

& Seafood Bronze Medalist Beautiful deep garnet color. Oak on the nose from the 50% new French oak barrel aging. Some berry and pepper notes, light but flavorful. Fruit all through the palate, round, watery feel in the mid-palate. Soft tannin and fruit finish that lingers. Perfect for pairing with most dishes. *47 cases produced. 13.8% ABV* 

### 2020 Cabernet Franc (\$40)

You'll be greeted by the beautiful deep garnet color. Allspice, peppercorn, dark cherry lead to cherry cola with black fruit and a hint of graham cracker on the nose. Some berry and pepper notes, light but flavorful with white pepper and tobacco on the finish. Medium acidity. Light tannin. Perfect for pairing with paella or steamed mussels with saffron. 14.5% ABV 47 cases produced. **[Release Date: Sept 1, 2023]**

### 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon (\$40)

 2023 PDX Wine & Seafood Silver Medalist |
 2023 McMinnville Wine Classic Silver
 Dark, rich ruby color. Full fruit in the mouthfeel, dried berry, plum. Smooth with hints of dark
 fruit. Strong tannin in the finish. 47 cases
 produced. 14.4% ABV

### 2020 Cabernet Sauvignon (\$40)

Aromas of red currant, vanilla bean, baking spice, cinnamon, baked strawberry, cedar. Smooth front palate with bright red currant. Juicy and lively on the palate. Super sippable. Pairs nicely with chocolate to bring out the Bing cherry on front and side palate. Low acidity. *50 cases produced. 13.8% ABV* [*Release Date: Sept 1, 2023* 

### 2019 Petit Verdot (\$40)

Lighter color than expected for Petit Verdot. Subtle nose, vanilla tones. 50% American oak aged. With lower acid and a softer finish than typical Petit Verdot, this wine is very drinkable today. *40 cases produced* 14.2% ABV

**2019 'Triomphe' (\$48)** | *36% Cab Sauv, 22% Petit Verdot, 18% Cab Franc, 14% Malbec, 10% Merlot* This vintage is a complex blend, well balanced and charismatic in the flavor profile. Aromas of dark raspberry, brambleberry, and anise. Palate: dark bright berry, marionberry, brambleberry & baked fruit, a hint of sarsaparilla, plum skin on the finish.


**2018 'Triomphe' (\$48)** | *25% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Cabernet Franc, 20% Merlot, 17% Petit Verdot, 13% Malbec* The deep red with youthful acid and zippy tannins offer complexity and make for a wine that is very approachable. The earthy intensity of the nose is met with a palate full of gentle tannins that are more refined and controlled, than extroverted. See if your nose picks up the cherry vanilla, sarsaparilla before you experience the full mouthfeel of dark fruit and light cedar that leads to a long finish.

2017 'Triomphe' (\$48) | 32% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 20% Petit Verdot, 20% Malbec, 8% Merlot The fruit opened to the nose after it found air in the goblet with cranberry, cola and dark berry. Encountering the palate, the dark fruits become more vibrant and even more complex with hibiscus and black pepper. Hints of dark chocolate truffle creates a full mouth with extra tannins and acid, to spare. **2016 'Triomphe' (\$48)** | *28% Cabernet Franc, 22% Petit Verdot, 22% Merlot, 18% Malbec, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon* Cedar, berry, black currant on nose, black cherry on front palate. Youthful tannin enjoyable now or cellar for special occasion. Balanced blend in mouthfeel with toasted vanilla notes from new oak.

How it's made: Every year our winemakers craft a classic Bordeaux-style blend using the principal grapes of Bordeaux. Each varietal is barrel aged for 16 months and a blend is determined based on a "better than the sum of all parts" for that year. The winning blend is barrel aged for 5 more months, then bottled and bottle-aged 14 months. Released first to our Cellar Club in the Fall, we then release to the public on Veterans Day, marking 38 months from vine to release.

## **Oregon Pinot Noir**

**2018 Pinot Noir (\$92)** This vintage truly represents what we've come to know and love about #TresslerVineyard and the 22 months aged in oak only exposed to Pinot. Its deep ruby color and the aromas of sandalwood, cherry, and strawberry with hints of pomegranate greet you at first swirl. Cherry and very ripe raspberry on the front-mid palate with lingering oak, mid-body tannin, and pleasant acidity which leave a lingering finish. This is another excellent Burgundian style Pinot.

## Italian Varietals & Blends

**2018 Barbera (\$88)** Intense red, vibrant. On the nose you'll be tempted with brandied or bourbon cherries. As it hits your palate tart cherry, underripe plum, underripe raspberry, and a hint of cherry cola this medium bodied dry wine is substantial and falls in line with the youthful, fruity complexity and smooth finish.

### 2017 Barbera (\$88)

This full-bodied Barbera exudes an aroma of maple, brown sugar, cinnamon, mint, thyme, eucalyptus, leather, and even a little smoke. Followed with flavors of butter, brown butter, caramel, and smoked jerky. It offers a great balance of acidity and tannin, taste is all up front, wraps with simple finish but it does linger.

**2015 Vino Barbitivo (\$94)** | 56% Barbera and 44% Primitivo **2**018 First Taste Oregon **LOW STOCK** Dark fruits, brambleberries; black, Marion berry on the nose followed by vanilla, cinnamon, and sandalwood. Medium plus to full bodied wine with fresh raspberry, rhubarb and spices, even white pepper, on the palate. Mouth coating tannin, warm alcohol, and a long finish with orange peel.

**2018 Sangiovese Super-Tuscan Style (\$92)** – the bright ruby color and shiny brilliance is a hint to the youthful vigor of this wine. Medium intensity nose is followed by bright fruit; strawberries, brambleberries, candied fruits and then maple, vanilla and cinnamon notes. Strong tannins balanced with fruit and acidity. Long acidity in the finish, mouthwatering. Will pair wonderfully with many savory dishes. *Our Sangiovese is crafted in a Super-Tuscan style with 5-8% Merlot aged in neutral oak only.* 

### 2017 Sangiovese, Super Tuscan style (\$78)

As you swirl, you'll see the beautiful dark, deep ruby color and pick up the aroma of dill, lavender, floral, elderberry, and yes, bacon fat. You may detect flavors of cranberry, tart cherry, blackberry, and strawberry and pick up the soft tannin in the mouth, with tart blueberry (acidity) in the lingering finish.

### 2016 Sangiovese, Super Tuscan style (\$78) LOW STOCK

Dried cherries, plum greets your nose with a hint of nutmeg and clove spice. Deep fruit, blackberry, some rhubarb on the palate. Medium body with Sangiovese acidity and moderate tannins on the finish.

## Large Format: 1.5L Magnums - Bordeaux Varietals & Blends

### 2017 Malbec (\$82)

Super dark purple in the glass with an aroma of forest in the morning after a rainy night, autumn leaves, mossy, fresh coffee, blackberry and black cherry, blueberry, over ripe fruit, old leather, black pepper. Nice and fruity on the palate, drops to the mid-palate and feels full. Medium tannin, smooth finish, medium long lasting.

**2018 Cabernet Franc (\$96)** - The nose is race-y. The youthful acid and fresh tannins in a medium body make this a memorable wine. Another vintage of the classic Cab Franc noting poblano pepper, hints of dried herbs and black cherry in this fruit forward palate with a dry mouthfeel overall. Fresh tannins, dance across the palate glorious in the complexity across the palate front to back.

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### 2017 Cabernet Franc (\$86) 🍯 2021 Sip! Classic Gold Medalist

Signature Cabernet Franc aroma of green bell pepper, jalapeno, black pepper, bay leaf, with a touch of smokymeat in a glass. Hints of licorice, wet grass, fresh cut, charred wood. Mouthfeel is meaty, even a little like wild game, ready for food. A little vanilla notes, smooth tannin and cola flavored gummies.

### 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon (\$96) 🥉 2022 PDX Wine & Seafood Bronze Medalist

Deep rich color and white pepper nose lead to such a refined body and mid-mouth tannin with this wine that enjoys subtle metamorphosis on the palate. Black cherry slowly converts to marionberry, dried herbs and cocoa powder. Lingering notes of cedar, charred beef, and leather.

**2017 Cabernet Sauvignon (\$86) 2** 2020 Sip! Classic Silver Medalist **2** 2021 OWP Cellar Selects Rich dark color, aromas jump out at you. Caramel, maple bar, cedar, oak, black pepper, caramel, cherry cola, blackberry, black cherry. More red fruit on the nose, more black fruit on the palate. A very smooth finish with acid and tannin well balanced.

## 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon (\$86) 🎽 Double Gold, Best in Show 2020 PDX Wine & Seafood Medalist |

🕉 2019 Sip! Classic Silver Medalist | 🕈 2020 OWP Cellar Select

Aromas of cherries, raspberry jam, plum entice your nose to linger. Fruity mid-palate and big mouthfeel. Cocoa and vanilla from 33% new American Oak. Positive tannins on the finish. Pairs well with chocolates.

### 2017 'Triomphe' (\$106) | 🕈 2020 Sip! Classic Silver Medalist

32% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Cabernet Franc, 20% Petit Verdot, 20% Malbec, 8% Merlot The fruit opened to the nose after it found air in the goblet with cranberry, cola and dark berry. Encountering the palate, the dark fruits become more vibrant and even more complex with hibiscus and black pepper. Hints of dark chocolate truffle creates a full mouth with extra tannins and acid, to spare. Finally, the pleasant finish is complex and long and you are left with cranberry and creamy vanilla on the back end.

### 2016 'Triomphe' (\$106) 🕈 2020 Sip! Classic Silver Medalist

10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Cabernet Franc, 22% Petit Verdot, 18% Malbec and 22% Merlot Cedar, berry, black currant on nose, black cherry on front palate. Youthful tannin enjoyable now or cellar for special occasion. Balanced blend in mouthfeel with toasted vanilla notes from new oak.

### 2015 'Triomphe' (\$106)

36% Cabernet Sauvignon, 27% Cabernet Franc, 14% Petit Verdot, 20% Malbec, 3% Merlot Rich dark crimson color. Smoked paprika, strong aromas of black fruits, wood, cedar, or sandalwood. Mouthfeel, full fruit, definite layers from the blend. Best quote: "Well rounded, hits on all cylinders start to finish."

### 2014 Triomphe (\$106) | 🍯 2018 PDX Wine & Seafood Bronze Medalist

11% Cabernet Sauvignon, 32% Cabernet Franc, 19% Petit Verdot, 23% Malbec, 15% Merlot Beautiful rich color, dried berries, and ripe fruit on the nose with pleasing vanilla from the oak. Very fruity midpalate and a long lingering finish of mild tannin and pleasant acidity.
