

2025 Portfolio Tasting Notes

Sparkling Wine + Oregon White Wines

'22 Blanc de Blancs Sparkling Wine (\$38)

Honeysuckle and vanilla on the nose followed by the creamy soft brioche on the front palate with a hint of lemon zest. Pear midpalate with an enjoyable dry finish. M. Champenoise 44 cases produced. 12.5% ABV

'22 Rosé Sparkling Wine (\$38)

Strawberry on the nose that continues on the front palate with cranberry notes. Barely sweet and fruity with a dry finish. Another Rosé Sparkling to add to your favorites. M. Champenoise 55 cases produced. 12.5% ABV

Sparkling wines: Clements Hills nested in Lodi AVA, CA

'23 Viognier (\$28)

A hot year produced this easy sipping full bodied wine with aromas of peach and hints of crisp freshly sliced apple (Jazz/Fuji). Followed by a luscious soft mouth feel with hint of sweetness on the finish. 89 cases produced. 13.3% ABV Deux Vert Vineyard, Yamhill-Carlton AVA

PDX Seafood & Wine Silver

'23 Chardonnay (\$28)

On the nose, hint of oak with Asian pear. Silky mouthfeel with white pineapple on the back palate. Harvested at full ripeness 33.3% of this wine spent four months on oak. 54 cases produced. 13.0 % ABV Scotch Church Road Vineyard, Tualatin Hills AVA

'23 Rose of Pinot Noir (\$28)

Delicate aromas of dried herbs and sun-ripened strawberries set the stage for this complex yet approachable Rosé. The palate unfolds with flavors of strawberry-rhubarb pie, bright acidity, and a cherry-infused midpalate, leading to a rich finish with subtle hints of baking spices. 56 cases produced. 13.3% ABV Scotch Church Road Vineyard, Willamette Valley AVA

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Oregon Pinot Noir

Tressler Vineyard, Laurelwood Dist. AVA, Chehalem Mountains, Willamette Valley Equal Parts Pinot Noir clones: Pommard, 113,115, 667,777

2022 Pinot Noir (\$40)

A smooth, vibrant blend of Pinot Noir clones with classic earthiness on the nose. Light in color with great clarity, it bursts with dark cherry, blackberry, and currant, balanced by a touch of spice. Soft tannins and a hint of pepper lead to a clean, lingering finish. Easygoing yet expressive! 14.3% ABV 53 cases produced.

2021 Barbera (\$40)

Light garnet in the glass. Aromatic hint of vanilla with medium tannin and high acidity enjoy the oregano followed by cherry cola on the palate. Medium finish. 14.8% ABV 48 cases produced. Horse Heaven Hills AVA, Alder Ridge Vineyard 2025 PDX Seafood & Wine Silver

2021 Sangiovese, Super-Tuscan Style (\$40)

6.3% Merlot Rich dark color with a fruity nose reminiscent of fruit punch. Cherry and ripe plum on the palate, medium-long finish. Medium acidity with medium tannins.

2021 Vino Barbitivo (\$48)

66% Barbera / 34% Primitivo Dark garnet, aromas of fig jam, vanilla, with baked cherry pie flavor. Rich tannin structure pleasantly coats palate. 14.9% ABV 26 cases produced 2025 Silver Medal – First Taste Oregon

2022 Primitivo (\$40)

This medium-dark red with exceptional clarity opens with aromas of boysenberry and dark chocolate. The palate is rich and full, featuring ripe cherry, dark Bing, and sweet plum, with subtle hints of butterscotch and vanilla. Complemented by ripe berries, medium-plus tannins, and a lingering finish, it's a bold, fruit-forward wine. 15.2% ABV 56 cases produced. Bottled 7/27/24 Stone Tree Vineyard Wahluke Slope AVA, Columbia Valley



Bordeaux & Rhone Varietals Columbia Valley

2022 Malbec (\$40)

Deep in color with perfect clarity, this Malbec opens with aromas of ripe plum, rose petals, and a hint of spice. The palate is rich with juicy plum and sweet blackberry, balanced by light pepper and a smooth, lingering finish. Full-bodied with medium tannins and mild acidity, it's bold yet beautifully balanced.

14.1% ABV 67 cases produced.

Red Willow Vineyard, Yakima Valley AVA

2021 Cabernet Franc (\$40)

A light brick-red hue with perfect clarity, this Cabernet Franc offers a subtle nose that evolves to reveal notes of vanilla, baked strawberry, and a hint of dried herbs. Low on traditional pyrazines, it features soft, medium tannins and balanced acidity. The full mouthfeel brings forward fruity, almost sweet flavors, leading to a smooth, lingering finish. 14.4% ABV 39 cases produced.

Red Willow and Alder Ridge Vineyards 50% Horse Heaven Hills AVA, 50% Yakima Valley AVA, Awards: 2025 Savor NW 88 pts Silver

2021 Cabernet Sauvignon (\$40)

Inviting notes of vanilla and dark cherry lead the nose, complemented by ripe plum, lush blackberry, and hints of cocoa nibs. Subtle undertones of toasted coconut add depth. A smooth entry on the front palate reveals rich flavors of ripe plum, sundried prune, and vibrant raspberry. Moderately firm tannins provide structure, while balanced acidity adds freshness. The finish lingers with hints of leather and tobacco, adding depth and refinement. 14.4% ABV, 55 cases produced. Alder Ridge Vineyard 100% Horse Heaven Hills AVA

2021 Petit Verdot (\$40)

Bright ruby red with dark hues, this Petit Verdot opens with floral notes and hints of dark fruit, root beer, and vanilla. As it opens, tart cherry evolves into plum and baked fig. Chewy with nice acidity and medium-plus tannins, it finishes with a smooth, lingering richness. 14.7% ABV 35 cases produced. Alder Ridge Vineyard Horse Heaven Hills AVA

2022 Syrah (\$48)

Crafted in a Côte Rôtie style with 6.9% Viognier, this deep, dark Syrah opens with a touch of smoke alongside ripe plum, blueberry, and dark cherry. A swirl reveals its luscious, chewy mouthfeel, carrying rich notes of blueberry, plum, dried strawberry, and blackberry into a long, lingering finish. With light acidity, this wine is bold yet elegantly layered. 14.7% ABV 69 cases produced.

2021 Triomphe Signature 5-Bordeaux Blend (\$48)

30% Cabernet Franc, 21% Malbec, 21% Petit Verdot, 18% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon Lovely nose with tobacco, rhubarb, ripe cherry and cassis. Smooth on the front palate this very dry yet smooth tannins deliver pomegranate, cacao and walnut shell with a white pepper finish. 14.3% ABV 53 cases produced. 2025 PDX Seafood & Wine Silver

2020 'Triomphe' (\$48)

32% Cab Sauv, 24% Cab Franc, 19% Petit Verdot, 16% Malbec, 9% Merlot Aromas of caramel with a hint of bubble gum. Palate: (not kidding) front palate picks up Bazooka Joe bubble gum. Mid-palate delivers raspberry, black pepper, paprika, dark fruit, and the essence of caramel. 13.9%ABV PDX Wine & Seafood Silver Medalist First Taste Oregon Silver

Triomphe is French for Triumph and a salute to the Arc de Triomphe, which honors those who fought and died for France during the French Revolution and the Napoleonic Wars.

How it's made: Every year our winemakers craft a classic Bordeaux-style blend using the principal grapes of Bordeaux.

Each varietal is barrel aged for 16 months and a blend is determined based on a "better than the sum of all parts" for that year. The winning blend is barrel aged for 5 more months, then bottled and bottle-aged 14 months.

Released first to our Cellar Club in the Fall, we then release to the public on Veterans Day, marking 38 months from vine to release.

Laurelwood District AVA, Chehalem Mountains

The Laurelwood District AVA, one of Oregon's newest AVAs, was approved in June 2020. Principals from Ponzi Vineyards and Dion Vineyards championed its petition. This AVA, which is nested within the Chehalem Mountains AVA, comprises more than 25 wineries and 70 vineyards. The Tressler vineyard is located at about 500 ft. elevation on the bluff on the west side of Parrett Mountain overlooking Newberg.

Willamette Valley AVA

A large AVA of 3,438,000 acres (5372 square miles), running from Portland in the north to Eugene in the south, it includes rich alluvial soils on the valley floor, that are great for agriculture but inappropriate for high quality grape growing, and a selection of volcanic, loess and sedimentary soils on hillsides of varying mesoclimates.

Yamhill-Carlton AVA

The coarse-grained, ancient marine sediments native to the Yamhill-Carlton AVA are among the oldest soils in the Willamette Valley. These soils drain quickly, making them ideal for viticulture. Thus, the vines stop growing shoots and leaves earlier here than elsewhere, leading to more complete ripening, even in cooler growing seasons. This boutique vineyard site is 200 to 400 above sea level and is predominantly south and east facing. The vineyard is LIVE and Salmon Safe Certified.
